2. Reasons for Revisions to Full-Year Financial Forecast

Because of weak demand and uncertainty in the electronic device market, such as PCs and tablet products, slow movement of and adjustments for inventories have been remarkable since the third quarter. In addition, investment in data centers is expected to continue to be restrained. Due to the impact of such external environments, sales of high-tech products and at the processing service business are expected to fall below the previous forecast.

As changes in the sales structure, including sales of these products, and steep rises in raw materials, energy, labor costs, and logistics costs have worsened profit margins, operating income, ordinary income, and profit attributable to owners of parent are expected to be lower than previously announced forecasts.
